# NIS Update – Site Closure



Somerset are ceasing delivery of:

KEEP Safe

KEEP Standard

Positive feedback from site on the impact of the programme.

Positive feedback from the site on the role of the NIS in their implementation of the model – both learning and delivery.

Costing, staffing and implementation fit are the main issues affecting sustainability of KEEP



# NIS Successes

- NIS continue to be recognised as a centre of excellence for supporting the implementation and development of Evidence based Interventions (Family Therapy Evidence Article, National Fostering Stocktake etc.)
- NIS continues to be an appealing agency to attract funding through various streams i.e. LCF, KPMG etc.
- Evidence base remains compelling and encouraging for all NIS programmes, including KEEP
- ODI reports that UK KEEP Fidelity is currently outstanding – well done everyone!



# NIS Challenges

- NIS is currently undergoing a period of Organisational Change
- Subsequently staff based within SLAM have either sought new employment or are subject to redeployment (Rowan – A.P., Dan B.M., Jess – Admin, Simon – S.M., Jo G. - S.C.)
- Contracted work is now transferring to MFT
- Staff within MFT are also now subject to Organisational change and are in a formal consultation period



# NIS Challenges

- NIS are tasked with securing site investment for the coming 12 months to inform the MFT consultation process
- NIS work steam will depend upon MFT approving existing work streams (or potential generation of new work)
- ODI are aware of the processes occurring and are preparing a support package for UK sites should the NIS no longer remain to service existing UK contracts



# NIS – Plan for Sites

We are currently and hope to remain “Business as Usual”

Based on MFT approval NIS will:

Continue to provide link support via Emma and Colin

Continue to provide training as required

Continue to provide consultation to unaccredited facilitators as required

Support the Coaching needs of all NIS Licensed Trainers

Provide 2x annual KEEP-Up Events

Provide Evaluation Data reports annually

Continued use of the member’s area of the Evidence Based Interventions website
